### RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE RENTAL RATE AT 1621 LAKE LANSING ROAD HASLETT MI 48840

**WHEREAS**, the Ingham County Parks Department owns and maintains a rental house located within Lake Lansing Park-South; and

**WHEREAS**, the current tenants have asked staff to evaluate rental house rates in the area to be more competitive in the rental house market; and

**WHEREAS**, park staff has identified similar rental house properties in the immediate area ranging from \$685.00 to \$775.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, the current rental house rate is \$930.00 per month, this rate was set in 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the lack of capital improvements, the house remained empty for six months and without this recommended change in fees, staff feels that the house will not be a viable, competitive rental property; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has recommended that a new rental house rate of \$800.00 per month (\$9,600.00/year) be set at 1621 Lake Lansing Road Haslett MI 48840; and

WHEREAS, this new rate will continue to include mowing and snow plowing services; and

WHEREAS, this new rate will become effective April 1, 2014.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Ingham County Parks & Recreation Commission recommends to the Ingham County Board of Commissioners that the rental house rate at 1621 Lake Lansing Road Haslett MI 48840 be adjusted to \$800.00 per month effective April 1, 2014.

### RESOLUTION TO REDUCE THE CONTRIBUTION TO THE LAKE LANSING WATERSHED AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MARINE AUTOMATED DOCK SYSTEMS COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL OF THE FISHING DOCK AT LAKE LANSING PARK SOUTH

WHEREAS, the Ingham County Parks Department contracted in 2011 with Marine Automated Dock Systems (MADS) for the purchase, initial installation and removal of an accessible fishing dock at Lake Lansing Park-South; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the complexity of the work and limited staff time, staff has identified the need for a professional dock installation company to install and remove the fishing dock at Lake Lansing Park-South; and

**WHEREAS**, the fishing dock at Lake Lansing Park-South have proven to be extremely popular with all park visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ingham County Parks Department would enter into an agreement with MADS for installation and removal of the dock; and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement will be evaluated on an annual basis to determine if park staffing levels are adequate to perform the tasks in-house or to continue this agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, funding has been identified by reducing the Lake Lansing Watershed annual payment from \$5,000.00 to \$2,500.00 to support the fishing dock installation.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Ingham County Parks & Recreation Commission recommends to the Ingham County Board of Commissioners that the annual \$5,000 contribution to the Lake Lansing Watershed be reduced to \$2,500.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Ingham County enters into an agreement with Marine Automated Dock Systems Company for the annual installation and removal of the Lake Lansing Park-South fishing dock in an amount not to exceed \$2,500.


### 2013 Statistical Data Report – Low Income Vehicle Fee Policy

This report is provided as requested by the Parks Commission in Resolution 19-13 Resolution Directing Staff to Collect Public Assistance Statistics Regarding the Low Income Vehicle Entry Fee Policy.

In 2013 the Ingham County Parks Department issued a total of 1,527 hardship passes to park visitors requesting a waiver of the vehicle entry fee. 2,928 children were provided no charge entry to the parks as a benefit of this program.

In July, the form completed by visitors requesting a waiver was changed to voluntarily request from visitor's information regarding any public assistance their family may receive.

The graph below reflects the information provided by customers during 3 weeks of July and the month of August 2013.
